Active membership in our club is down slightly. Last year at this time we had 251 active members. Today we have 236, down 6%.

This downturn may reflect the current economic climate. It may also recognize that we have not published our newsletter, the WOW, in almost a year.

Earlier this month, Randy Walker, our President, posted comments about our WOW shortfall in the discussion forum on the club's website (www.101scout.org). Please read those comments if you have not already done so.

Randy explained that the club's Board of Directors has taken steps to resolve the problems going forward. But, the Board must still resolve, at the November annual meeting, how to compensate the membership for the missing 2010 newsletters.

Consequently, the usual membership renewal form is not included with the mailing of this WOW, v26n4 (4Q09). It would be unfair to ask members to renew until the Board has completely resolved all newsletter issues (which we absolutely intend to do).
